Tastemaking gallery Anat Ebgi has announced representation of the Indian artist Soumya Netrabile. The artist currently has a solo show, "Between past and present/ Between appearance and memory" at one of the gallery's three Los Angeles locations, on view until October 21st.

Born in 1966 in Bangalore, India, Netrabile paints dreamlike, nature-inspired canvases awash with yellows, pinks, and greens that nudge at the edges of abstraction. Netrabile has been featured in recent solo exhibitions including at Pt.2 Gallery in Oakland, CA; Andrew Rafacz in Chicago; and The Journal, New York. She has also exhibited in group exhibitions at galleries including Rachel Uffner Gallery, Trinta Gallery, indigo+madder, and Karma. The artist lives and works in Chicago.
